Let's Talk Co-op!

- The Kitsap Community Food Co-op (KCFC) will be a full service grocery store providing all of the services of other local grocery stores, but focusing on local, natural foods
- Anyone can become a member of the store, and anyone can shop there. You don't have to be a member to shop!
- Other local food co-ops: PCC, Port Townsend Food Co-ops, Skagit Valley Food Co-op
- We will focus on local, natural foods but will offer conventional items as well
- It is a one-time investment of \$200 to become a member-owner, and there are three payment plans.
- KCFC members can use their membership cards at other local food co-ops to benefit from their member programs right now!
- Member-owners will share in the profits of the store through patronage dividends
- Money spent at the food co-op will circulate within our community several times; money spent at corporately owned stores generally leaves our community right away.
- The co-op is literally owned by hundreds or thousands of households, right here in Kitsap County!
- There are all kinds of co-ops in Kitsap: Group Health Cooperative, REI, Kitsap Poultry Growers Cooperative, Poulsbo Cooperative Preschool, Kitsap Credit Union
